

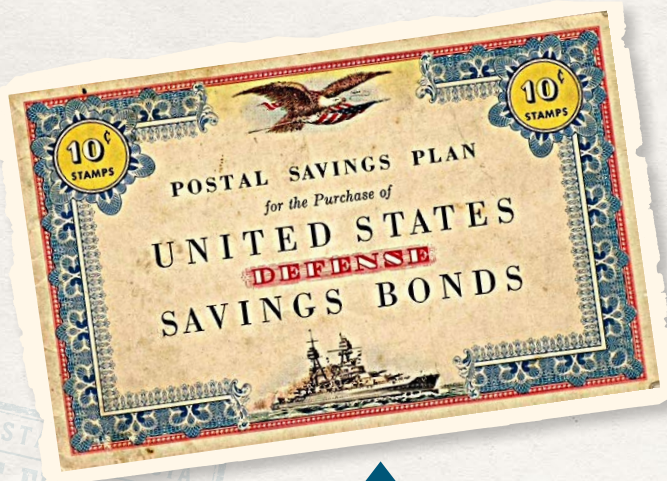
WORLD WAR II HISTORY TRAVELING TRUNKS

The CGHS History Traveling Trunks, developed by Caitlyn Price and funded by a grant from the Terry Thomas Foundation, were created with 5th-grade World War II state standards in mind. The trunks are interactive mobile history exhibits for hands-on learning to supplement teachers' lessons with additional information and lesson plans about WWII and, more specifically, the Home Front. The trunks include various lesson plans, 3D printed replica objects created by the College of Coastal Georgia, propaganda posters, games, and more to bring the past to life for young students.

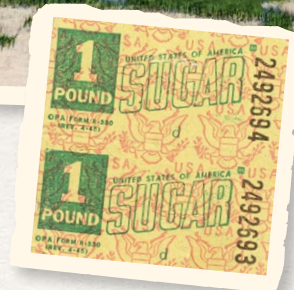
